Welcome and thank you for choosing our clinic in your quest for optimum health. We are committed to delivering excellent health care service. We will do all we can to meet your health needs. This letter tells you about our staff and policies of the Centre.

APPOINTMENTS

You should know that the Centre is very busy and the wait time at the office could be between one-two hours.

Reminders and Missed Appointments

Two business days before your visit, the receptionist will phone with a reminder for booked appointment. Please reply to her message. However any cancellations require two business days notice otherwise a charge of \$70.00 is applied as for a missed appointment (no show).

Questions and Concerns

Questions and concerns that cannot wait for the next appointment should be sent by fax or e-mail only. We will respond to your concerns usually within 24-48 hours. Over the phone consultations are discouraged.

Dr. Jacconello and Dr. Mildon review all laboratory tests results on a regular basis. You will be contacted **only** if your lab test results are of an urgent nature.

Wheelchair access

Please let us know if a wheelchair access is necessary, so we arrange any help needed to enter the building.

HEALTH CARE PERSONNEL

Medical Doctors

Dr. Paul Jacconello, MD and Founder of the Jacconello Health Centre sees patients with a variety of illnesses.

Dr. C. Anne Mildon, MD specializes in chronic fatigue syndrome, rheumatic and infection problems. However, she takes on patients with a variety of problems.

Naturopathic Doctor

Adrian Nasager, ND sees new patients of Dr. Jacconello to evaluate test results and to fine-tune the implementation of their programs (the charge is included in your initial fee). He provides detoxification, weight loss and diet programs as well. He sees his own patients as well who are in needs of a naturopathic care. His visits may be covered under your insurance.

Certified Nutritional Practitioner

Patricia Meyer-Watt, CNP reviews the "Nutrition Questionnaire" form that is completed for Dr. Jacconello's first visit and provides diet recommendations. The cost of this visit is covered by the first appointment payment. She can be seen for nutritional advice.

Doctor of Homeopathy

Usha Passi, BDS, HD provides Homeopathy counseling, carries out various tests such as food and environmental sensitivities, as well as, their treatments.

Environmental Counselor

Maya Fabiszak, Master of Science, provides Dr. Jaconello's patients with information on environmental and life style adjustments that are necessary in order to obtain a better state of health.

Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) Practitioner, Acupuncturist

Dr. Hui Rong (Helen) Zhang has over 35 years of clinical experience in both China and Canada. She specialized in acupuncture, acupressure and Tai Na (therapeutic massage).

Board Certified Clinical Thermographer

Edyta Wojdalowicz delivers Thermography service, a screening procedure that captures images of the breast to aid in the earlier detection of the breast irregularities.

Paramedical Esthetics

Mona Rezaei provides natural rejuvenating treatments.

Laboratory Personnel

Carries out and takes samples for various tests. They administer treatments as prescribed by the doctors and also obtain lab results for the doctor to review.

Administrative Staff

Schedule appointments, direct patients to the appropriate area for service or other practitioners, collects payments, submits claims to OHIP, looks after referrals and takes messages.

PLEASE REFRAIN FROM USING ANY SCENTED PRODUCTS WHEN VISITING THE CLINIC: PERFUMES, SHAMPOOS, AFTER SHAVES, DEODORANTS AND SOAPS. Please do not bring any pets into the clinic. Many of our patients suffer from severe environmental allergies and this is for their protection.

SEQUENCE THROUGH THE CLINIC

Dr Jaconello's New Patients Program appointments are listed below and scheduled approximately in two weeks intervals.

INITIAL VISIT

Please, complete all forms that have been sent to you prior to your first visit.

These preparations should be followed for the first visit:

- No alcohol consumption for 24 hours
- 2-4 glasses of water within 2 hours of visit
- No exercise, caffeine or food for 4 hours prior to arrival

This visit usually lasts three to four hours and during this time the following will occur:

- 1) Weight, height and blood pressure readings are taken.
- 2) Blood will be taken for various blood tests. Two tablespoons of pubic hair will be required for hair analysis test. If the amount is insufficient, hair from the head will be used. In this case hair should not be colored within last three weeks. Other test performed will include body composition (BIA) and cardiovision.
- 3) Completing any forms that have not been finished and obtaining various consents.
- 4) Full history intake and physical examination by Dr. Jaconello.
- 5) Discussion of any health problems and an initial treatment program composed by Dr. Jaconello. This program might include supplements and intravenous treatments. Additional tests may be prescribed at that time.
- 6) If you have a previous history of inhalant allergies, a scratch test will be conducted to obtain new information.

THE SECOND VISIT is with the Dr. Nasager, ND who reviews available test results and ensures that patients carry out Dr. Jaconello's directions. This visit is 1 hour long. If any more time is desired another appointment is made.

THE THIRD VISIT is with the Nutritionist. This visit is 1 hour long as well.

A GROUP SESSION will be held with the Environmental Health Consultant who will counsel on the impact of the environment on your health and advise you on the necessary changes that will serve well on your road to health (approximately 2 hours long).

THE FOURTH VISIT is again with Dr. Jaconello who further reviews the test results and places patients on the complete complementary treatment program. This visit is approximately 1 hour long and can be recorded on a tape or I-Phone.

THE FIFTH VISIT is with Dr. Nasager, ND and is scheduled in three months after the initial visit. Patient progress is reviewed and necessary changes made. This visit is approximately 30 minutes long.

FOLLOW-UP VISITS will be with Dr. Jaconello, approximately one-two per year. Parts of the follow-up visits are reimbursed by OHIP and parts are a complementary cost to the patient. Patients are welcome to book with Dr. Nasager, ND in between visit with Dr. Jaconello. Follow-up appointments are extremely important as they allow modification of your treatment program, if needed.

PAYMENT FOR SERVICE

A portion of the visit with Dr. Jaconello is covered by OHIP. Please make sure that both your OHIP number and address are correct. The OHIP claim is submitted on your behalf and then OHIP reimburses you directly. A separate cost applies when complementary topics are discussed. Payment for both the OHIP and complementary part of the visit is paid to Dr. Jaconello. The method of payment is cheque, cash or debit. If payment is by cheque, please bring two cheques for your first visit. One cheque is payable to Dr. Jaconello and the other to Preventimed. This latter cheque covers the cost of the test and other practitioner's visits. **PAYMENT IS DUE AT THE TIME OF THE VISIT.**

Dr. Jaconello's New Patients Program fee structure includes all testing and four specialized visits **NOT COVERED BY OHIP:**

Please note: an additional cost applies for the **FOURTH VISIT** with Dr. Jaconello, which will be reimbursed to you by OHIP.

In Dr. Jaconello's **FOLLOW-UP VISITS**, there are areas of therapy that would be considered innovative and thus not covered by OHIP (please see IMPORTANT INFORMATION – NEW PATIENT). The fee for such services is **\$62.50** for the first 15 minutes and **\$21.50** per 5 minutes of discussion thereafter.

Dr. Mildon's Patients

Dr Mildon is taking new patients.

OHIP covers the visits. Dr Mildon may ad additional charge for services not covered by OHIP as complementary. However, you will be informed about it.

Specific lab tests are ordered for each patient as necessary.

Blood pressure and pulse are taken at each visit.

Visits usually last 45 minutes.

For prescription renewals and questions there are 15 minutes appointments.

Forms to be completed by the doctor have to be given to the receptions right upon arrival.

Patients are rescheduled for next appointments with Dr. Mildon.

Dr. Mildon doesn't provide advice over the phone. Please make an appointment with Dr. Mildon to discuss your questions.

Administrative Uninsured Services

It is unlawful for any physician to charge or accept payment for rendering an insured service in excess of the amount payable under the Ontario Health Insurance Plan (OHIP). However, there are a number of services that are not insured by OHIP that might be adjuncts to insured medical services and are administrative in nature.

These uninsured services may be billed directly to you.

As part of your good medical care, is expected that you will be provided from time to time with uninsured services. The following is the cost of each uninsured service that the doctor is professionally obligated to tell you.

A list of these services and their corresponding costs are as follows:

- Telephone advice provided by me at your request.....**\$250.00 per hour**
- Toll charges for long distance telephone calls..... **at cost**
- Renewals of prescriptions by telephone or fax.....**\$20.00 per renewal***
- *Dr. Mildon does not renew prescriptions via telephone or fax.**
- Providing prescriptions at patient request and no other insured service is provided **\$20.00**
- Preparation of Medicolegal reports based on the time taken..... **\$200.00 per hour**
- Completion of various forms, notes and documents.....**\$15.00 - \$50.00 per form**
- Sick or return to work note..... **\$15.00**
- Pre-Employment certificate of fitness..... **\$25.00**
- Daycare form to verify free of communicable disease..... **\$15.00**
- Medical report for Canadian Immigrants.....**\$100.00**
- Disability Tax Certificate..... **\$35.00**
- Preparation and transfer of health records when done at patient's request **\$35.00**

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IMPORTANT INFORMATION – NEW PATIENT

Introduction

You may well have come here searching for alternative ways to help solve your health problems and are considering treatments, which are not in the mainstream of medical care.

OHIP does not consider such endeavors medically necessary and thus does not cover any health care under the umbrella of “alternative”, “complementary” or “innovative”.

This practice is predominantly complementary, and since many of the services are not considered insurable by Ontario’s Health Insurance Act, they will be charged to you and are not recoverable from OHIP. However, part of your visits to see Dr. Jaconello are OHIP covered, as they are deemed medically necessary.

The following information gives you an outline of our fee structure.

Your *first visit* will involve a general assessment to get your full medical history and to ascertain your medical status. This will involve a full examination, which will be covered by OHIP. Follow up visits will be partly covered by OHIP in the form of counseling, which will involve an educational dialogue to develop and increase your awareness of your problems or situation and will advise you on modalities for prevention and for treatment with respect to your health status. This will include advice on your diet, stress management, exercise, smoking and general lifestyle as it relates to your health maintenance and prevention.

I will inform you as to the demarcation between the OHIP service and the complementary component of your health care.

It is difficult to be totally cut and dried about this and there will be times when both modalities integrate especially towards the end of the visit when both the non- complementary and complementary management are summed up.

Follow up visits

There are areas of therapy that would be considered innovative and thus not covered by OHIP. These include:

- Advice and treatment of toxic metal body burden and their removal.
- Advice on the treatment of autism including diets, nutrient therapy and chelation of toxic metals.
- Advice on the treatment of cardiovascular disease with EDTA chelation therapy
- Implementation of nutritional detoxification programmes
- Off- label use of prescription drugs in the management of health related issues
- Advice and treatment of non-atopic food allergies as related to elimination diets, environmental precautions and the use of low dose immunotherapy in their management.
- Advice related to the use of nutritional supplements both orally and parenterally to treat health problems.
- Advice and treatment of any kind not currently and generally accepted and not considered appropriate by the consensus of the medical profession.

The fee for such services is \$62.50 for the first 15 minutes and \$21.50 per 5 minutes of discussion thereafter.

Initial and Follow up Visit Protocol

3. Visit Sequencing

Initial visit is with Dr. Jaconello and includes a history and physical (OHIP), complementary assessment and initiation of complementary treatment programme.

Second visit is an appointment with Dr. Jaconello's Intern who reviews some test results and ensures that patient carry out Dr. Jaconello's directives.

Third visit is with the Nutritionist who reviews the Diet Diary and makes recommendations.

Fourth visit is with Dr. Jaconello who reviews the complete test results and places patient on the complete complementary program (approximately \$100 is covered by OHIP and will be reimbursed to you. The remaining is covered in the initial fee)

Fifth visit is with Dr. Jaconello's Intern, Naturopathic Doctor (Candidate) who reviews the patient progress and makes necessary changes. (The cost of this appointment is covered in the initial visit costs). This completes the cost of the new patient protocol and follow up visits are now indicated. A sixth follow-up visit will be with Dr. Jaconello of which you will have between two and six per year. Part of this visit is covered by OHIP and part is a complementary cost to the patient).

A group session will be held with the environmental specialist who will counsel on the impact of the environment on your health and advise you on the necessary changes that should be made to improve well being. The cost of this session is covered in the first visit.

Have you seen our new clinic yet?



The time has come to bring new services and treatments to you, as promised.

We want to give you a brief description of them, as well as, introduce the staff members who will be instrumental in their implementation.

THESE TREATMENTS AND TESTS WILL BE PERFORMED INDIVIDUALLY OR AS A SET.

THEY ARE AIMED AT:

- **NATURAL PAIN MANAGEMENT**
- **RELAXATION**
- **DETOXIFICATION**
- **INCREASING MENTAL ALERTNESS**
- **RESTORING YOUR ENERGY LEVELS**

The following is a description of the above **services**:

The Egoscue method developed by Pete Egoscue, a nationally renowned physiologist and sport injury consultant to some of today's top athletes, has a 95 percent success rate for eliminating chronic pain without drugs, surgery, or expensive physical therapy. The key is a series of gentle exercises and carefully constructed stretches called E-cises.

Bio-Identical Hormone Replacement Therapy resets and adjusts the hormonal balance for men and women of all ages. The treatment is tailored to each person and targeted to specifically remedy your unique symptoms.

NaProTECHNOLOGY (Natural Procreative Technology) can be defined as a new women's health science that is designed to cooperate with the menstrual and fertility cycles. NaProTECHNOLOGY is the first system to fully network family planning with procreative and gynecologic-health monitoring and maintenance. Its use has applications in family planning, the evaluation and treatment of infertility and other reproductive disorders. These disorders can include recurrent miscarriage, abnormal bleeding, various abnormal hormone conditions of menstrual cycle such as premenstrual syndrome and recurrent ovarian cysts. Other applications are: the dating of the beginning of pregnancy, the prevention of preterm birth and postpartum depression.

Massage therapy improves circulation by bringing oxygen and other nutrients to body tissues. It relieves muscle and joint tension and pain, as well as increasing flexibility and mobility.

Acupuncture originated from a 5000 year old tradition of Chinese medicine. Thin needles are inserted into patients skin to correct the flow of qi or energy throughout pathways in the body called meridians. After an assessment is made, the treatment takes about 30 minutes and is most effective if done sequentially over a several week period. Acupuncture is relatively painless and commonly used to treat all sorts of pain and organ dysfunctions. In some cases the benefits can even be immediate. Acupuncture has the distinct advantage of having a very long history of traditional use and thousands of modern studies measuring its benefits.

Acupressure is similar to acupuncture in that the same set of points are use. Acupuncture pressure is applied usually by the practitioner's finger instead of using needles. Most people expect acupressure to be less painful than acupuncture, in fact, the opposite is usually true. Acupressure is more tactile with direct contact between patient and practitioner and can be integrated in to other manual therapies such as massage and active release.

Homeopathy is a system of therapy based on the concept that disease can be treated with drugs (in minute doses) thought capable of producing the same symptoms in healthy people as the disease itself. According to homeopathy, symptoms are the body's way of fighting disease. Homeopathy teaches that symptoms are to be encouraged, by prescribing a "remedy" in minuscule doses that in large doses would

produce the same symptoms seen in the patient. These remedies are meant to stimulate the immune system, helping to cure the illness.

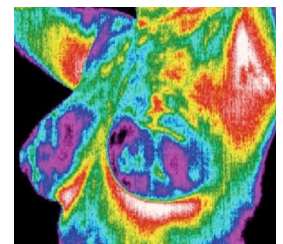

The following is a description of a new **tests** that will be offered:

Breast Thermography is a screening procedure that captures images of the breast to aid in the earlier detection of breast irregularities. It is comfortable and safe, using neither radiation nor compression.



Thermal image

Thermology can detect tumors 8-10 years before mammogram and with 90 percent accuracy. Early detection is the best defense against breast cancer and if treated in the earliest stages, a 95 percent chance of cure is achieved.

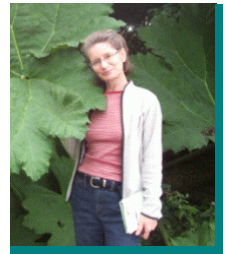
Provocative/biological testing - is the administration of a small amount of an allergen under the skin to determine if an allergic reaction occurs. Serums then can be made to suppress these symptoms and three months supply will be sent home with the patient. An allergen is a substance that causes one to react in various ways.

The Heidelberg pH Diagnostic System is a tool for measuring the pH levels in the digestive tract. The pH capsule used in the system is non-invasive and patient friendly. It is swallowed by the patient and measures the stomach acidity level to discover if there is any sign of over or under production of hydrochloric acid as both of these can cause problems with the digestion and absorption of nutrients.

Tips for avoiding the flu

Here are some ideas to help you through the flu season.

1. Take the following supplements

VITAMIN C 1000 - 2000 MG - 4 times a day

VITAMIN A 10,000 IU - 2 capsules once a day

VITAMIN D 1000 IU - 2 times per day

IMMUCORE by *Metagenics* - 1 tablet 3 times a day or

IMMUNE SUPPORT by *AOR* - 1 capsule 3 times a day.

Probiotics such as **PROFLORA** by *Professional Health Products* - 2 capsules twice a day will increase white blood cell activity and increase natural killer cells in blood stream.

2. The following essential oils may be used

Oils of **oregano**, **rosemary**, **eucalyptus** and **cloves**.

Add 2 drops of **Eucalyptus Oil** in a steam inhaler at night or use in your area of work or in different rooms. One can use a pocket inhaler or add 2 drops to a bowl of hot water and put a towel overhead to make a tent and breath the vapor.

3. Intravenous treatment for acute illness.

Intravenous **hydrogen peroxide** is given every other day alternating with 50 gm of intravenous **vitamin C** for up to 3 weeks. These drips are available in our office.

There are other intravenous treatments. Please consult with Dr. Jaconello before it develops into an illness.

4. Additional treatments

Bacterial vaccines

These are oral vaccines. They are made of killed oral bacteria from the throat, which stimulates immunity in the airway. Bacterial vaccines are backed by research and a double-blind trial has shown a protective effect in influenza. Modern oral bacterial vaccines are licensed in Europe but not in the US or Canada.

The following can be ordered on your behalf:

Broncho-Vaxon is a Swiss preparation manufactured by Laboratories O.M. It can be ordered on your behalf from an International Pharmacy. The prophylactic dosage is:

1 capsule daily for 10 days and repeat the 10 day course at 1 month intervals. Repeat with 1 course every 10 days for 3 months.

5. Homeopathy

Various homeopathic remedies are available for the flu. Please make an appointment with our Homeopathic Doctor who recently join our team.

Final commentary

Although the above measures are to boost your immune system, one must remember the following:

- ☺ Wash hands frequently
- ☺ Keep hands away from the face
- ☺ Eat a diet high in antioxidants
- ☺ Drink lots of warm fluids, which will wash the virus away from your throat (sinus rinses may be used, as well, for the nasal cavity).
- ☺ Get proper sleep
